

- The 16-digit number printed on the EBT card
- Create a username for account



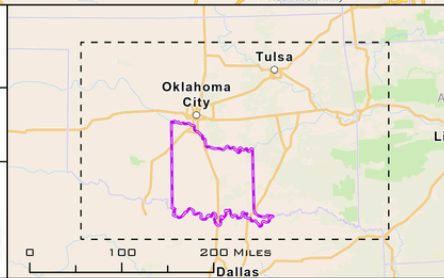
